Financial Report: Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual (July 2023 – June 2024)

Erin noted that to date the total incurred expenses for the 2023/2024 Recreation Budget is 42%, which is good. The snow shovels were purchased at the end of last year and are in good shape for this winter.

Program Reports:

Kids Programs:

Mohawk Ski program: thirty-two people signed up as of Saturday, the registration closed on 12/18/2023. "Ho" – "Ho" Hotline, Thursday, December 21st Friday, December 22nd.

Erin requested ideas for half day/full day programs for kids when school is closed. Erin suggests using Camp Coch as the library is too small to have programs in collaboration on no school or half days. Erin is checking with All Star transportation to see what solution can be found to transport children from school to Camp Coch.

Adult Programs:

Yoga: Chair and traditional Yoga continues. Evening Yoga has been postponed.

Adult Basketball: Mike Bates coach; \$5.00 drop-in fee. Very well attended.

Volleyball: Mike Prause, Thursdays 6:30 p.m., December 7th though April 2024.

Family/Community Programs:

Old Business:

Proposed wage increase was forwarded to the Board of Selectmen and teh Board of Finance. e report, *Plans for Summer Camp 2024*, was previously forwarded onto the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance for their consideration. Spread Sheets Plans for Summer Camp 2024 were included: Salaries, programs, fees, costs. Wages for Counselors, and other personnel were reviewed.

Ice cream and pizza are now included in the price so all children will have the food when it is available. Total costs for the town for the camp is \$76,205.46 for 6 weeks. The camp averaged seventy-five kids a week (90-65), approximately thirty were not residents.

In a **motion** made by Patrick Lucas, seconded by Nanci Howard. It was **voted** to approve the camp fee increases to \$195 for residents and \$225 for non-residents for the 2024 Camp season. Voted unanimous.

New Business:

Erin reported that Cono Gallo fell while working at Camp Coch. Jerry is helping with duties.

Adjournment: In a motion made by Patrick Lucas, seconded by Susan Breakell, it was voted to adjourn the meeting at 7:41 p.m. Voted unanimous.
