1. Call to order: Todd M. Carusillo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

2. Approval of the minutes of the meeting of March 22, 2022:

4. Approval of the Payroll and Warrant – March 31, 2022:

5. First Selectman's Report:

Last week COVID-19 cases in Litchfield County were down to "0" last week, however, the number is now up to 3.

The water filtration system repair at Camp Coch is moving along; water test results have been received and awaiting quotes for a filtration system.

Information from the Tax Collector. Collections: Real Estate – 99.21%; Personal Property – 99.27%; Motor Vehicle – \$97.68; Motor Vehicle Supplement – \$91.75%

From October 2021 thru December 2021, the fees for Goshen's portion of the use of the Torrington Animal Control Program & Facility is \$5,576.00. Todd will seek advice from our Attorney Chip Roraback to rescind Goshen's membership in this contract. Accordingly, Todd has two other Animal Facilities that are interested in serving Goshen's animal control duties – Canaan Animal Control and Katalyst Kennels. He will report soon.

6. Public Comment:

Cindy Barrett, when walking Ives Road, noticed that several metal road signs were broken. Garret Harlow, Supervisor of Public Works, reported that they have metal replacements – new posts and signs coming in.

Henrietta Horvay asked how to obtain the rules/regulations for driveways. Mark Harris advised her to go to the Goshen Town website where the Town Ordinances are listed accordingly or talk with Garret Harlow on issues regarding driveways.

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7. Correspondence:

Eversource has asked if the Town of Goshen would consider having an electric charger (Juice Bar) installed in the Town Hall Parking lot. Todd will report back with additional information and advise the BOF.

Members of Litchfield/Region 6 presented the benefits of "regional" school merger. Joyce Mowery, Paul Collins and Mady Flynn spoke to Todd regarding the benefits of Sustainable CT. They are working on projects such as compost bins, floral tree plantings, solar energy, etc.; moving in the right direction.
