1 Call to order: Robert P. Valentine, First Selectman called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m.

## 4. Approval of Payroll and Warrant - December 26, 2019:

In a motion made by Mark S. Harris, seconded by Robert P. Valentine, it was voted to approve the total warrant and payroll for December 26, 2019 in the amount of $\$ 68,394.70$. Included in this warrant were the payroll in the amount of $\$ 25,989.37$ and the warrant in the amount of $\$ 42,405.33$. Voted unanimous. ## Approval of Payroll and Warrant - January 2, 2020:

In a motion made by Mark S. Harris, seconded by Robert P. Valentine, it was voted to approve the total warrant and payroll for January 2, 2020, in the amount of $\$ 1,386,836,91$. Included in this warrant were the payroll in the amount of $\$ 19,922.06$ and the warrant in the amount of $\$ 1,375,914.85$. Voted unanimous. Included were payments for: Litchfield CTY Dispatch (911) \$16,649.32; MIRA (Tipping fees) \$8,796.34; Reg. 6 (1/6 assessment) \$1,339,264.00.

## Approval of Payroll and Warrant - January 9, 2020:

In a motion made by Mark H. Harris, seconded by Dexter S. Kinsella, it was voted to approve the total warrant and payroll for January 9, 2020, in the amount of $\$ 41,520.69$. Included in this warrant were the payroll in the amount of $\$ 28,052.67$ and the warrant in the amount of $\$ 13,648.02$. Voted unanimous. Included were payments for Dime Oil (heal, diesel) $\$ 4,795.62$; Eversource $\$ 3,051.38$.

## 6. First Selectman's Report:

Bob is reviewing employees' medical insurance quotes combining Region 6, Town of Litchfield and Woodridge Lake. There appears to be some savings with Connecticut Care verses our current carrier Anthem Blue Cross/Blue Shield. However, our agent is still reviewing with best options available.

Referring to Bob Valentine's attendance at the Northwest Hills Council of Governments meeting recently wherein the members were advised of a grant - Regional Performance Incentive Program - available to the towns. (Ref. min. 12/17/19) A meeting took place in Torrington recently with Mayor Elinor Carbone, Denise Rapp, First Selectman of Litchfield; Police Chief, William Baldwin, and Katlin Neild wherein an application was

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submitted for the balance of the funds need to construct a facility. (Lowest bid came in at \$1,900,000. Total dollars appropriated $\$ 1,000,000$.)

Bob Valentine reported that Small Town Economic Assistance Program (STEAP) grant dollars (\$10,000,000.) have been approved by the legislature and Bonding Commission. While priorities for these grant dollars have not been set, it is hoped that Goshen will be able to make application for playground equipment at Camp Cochipianne. Recreation Director, Colleen Kinkade, will be preparing information regarding the new playground equipment and potential request.

Bob Valentine will attend a meeting by MIRA (Materials Innovation \& Recycling Authority) in Hartford. This meeting will bring an update on the efforts to create a process for updating the current MIRA facility in line with DEEP selection of Sacyr Rooney as a contractor for the facility. All indications are costs for trash and recycling will be increased substantially.
