5. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Richard McCarty, LDM Squared for Alfred J & Margaret Mascia-358 East Hyerdale Drive-Shoreline Stabilization

Mr. McCarty presented his sketch of the area and his plan for the wall reconstruction. Mr. McCarty is planning to remove the old wall which was back filled with large rock and material but no fabric paper. He is going to tear down the existing wall, put proper drainage behind the new wall, fabric paper and fill with proper material. The wall will run the length of the property line along the shore, minus about 3' which is a drainage way between this lot and the one next to it. The newly constructed wall will not expand beyond the existing conditions and most of the rocks in the current wall will be reused.

MOTION by Mr. Turri seconded by Mr. Kinsella to accept the application Richard McCarty, LDM Squared for Alfred J & Margaret Mascia-358 East Hyerdale Drive-Shoreline Stabilization. No further discussion. **Motion carries.**

6. INLAND WETLANDS ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S REPORT:

The EO's report was presented. There was discussion on the progress of the solar array at Goshen Center School. The ground work is complete and the panels should be going up. There were no problems noted with the transportation of products across the playing fields in the back of the school. Discussion on various projects on the report. Mr. Stansfield inquired on the process of an Agent Determination. Mr. Connor explained that an Agent Determination can be granted if there is no significant activity, of any sort, not in the wetlands but in regulated area, and not warranting presentation to the Commission. Mrs. Lucas asked if the Enforcement Officer's report can be posted to the website with the minutes. The Clerk and Mr. Connor will coordinate to get those posted with the minutes. The Agent Determinations do get filed in the newspaper and posted in the Town Clerks office and 14 days are given for parties to appeal the determination before the project can begin per State Statute.

MOTION Mr. Turri second Mr. Kinsella, to accept the Inland Wetlands enforcement report. Motion carries.
