Woodridge Lake report by Chris, stated that the lake has remarkably fewer weeds. Great results and recommended not to restock carp next year. With all the rain, large number of fish have gone over the spillway. At one count over 100, some carp and some large. Have been able to retrieve some with nets. Looking forward to a great year in 2022.

Lida Exstein reports for Dog Pond that Near has done a survey. Water Quality is generally good. NEAR to evaluate North End for heavy weed growth. May use DASH or Hydro raking next spring. Fund raiser a success. To apply for a 501 © 3 nonprofit status.

West Side Pond reported by Simon Ellis. They have not yet received their permit or Grant from DEEP. The main concern besides Variable Milfoil is the Lilly Pads. No new outbreaks of curly leaf or variable milfoil.

Tyler Lake report by Mark & Marty Harris stated that a preliminary report from Hillary indicated she is not happy with our Sonar results so far. Will be examining the cause and retreatment not impossible for next year. Water quality is great.
