Ray Turri, President Woodridge Lake Sewer District, gave a presentation on the progress that WLSLSD has made in providing a high quality sewer system for the residents of Woodridge Lake. The process began in 1974 and has evolved to current plans to connect to the sewer system in Torrington. Working with the DEEP, the connection plan will take approximately two years. First Selectman, Valentine and the WPCA Commission received a letter dated February 9, 2016, from Zoning Enforcement Officer of Goshen, Martin Connor, that the plans are consistent with the Town of Goshen Plan of Conservation and Development. Mr. Turri reported that WLSLSD is awaiting a letter of intent from the City of Torrington to arrive before April, 2016.

Bob Valentine advised that the Goshen WPCA needs to identify the areas of avoidance in the map for the connection. He suggested that Attorney Chip Roraback can provide sample language necessary for this clarification.

Continuing their work on updating the *Water Pollution Control Plan (1988)*, Chairman Zavagnin directed the members to e-mail their designated updated sections of the report to Russ Hurley, who will put them all together for membership review.

In a motion made by Jeff Lindstrom, seconded by Russ Hurley, it was voted to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m. Voted unanimous.
