APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

IN A MOTION made by Russ Hurley, seconded by Jeff Lindstrom, it was VOTED that the minutes of the meeting of July 19, 2016 were approved as submitted. Voted unanimous.

Woodridge Lake Sewer District:

An update has found that the Torrington Water Company has filed for “intervenor status” on this proposed sewer hookup project. The Water Company’s President, Susan Suhanovsky stated the pipeline would threaten the Water Company’s 5,000 acres of watershed that provides drinking water for 40,000 residents of Torrington. The pipeline would bisect a portion of the watershed. This action has placed this WLSD project on hold until further directives are issued by both parties.

Henrietta Horvay strongly suggested that *costs* for public hearing notices in the newspapers regarding this project be borne in a cumulative effort by all parties. The public hearings are informational to all residents and rather than have individual meetings, repeating the same information over and over again, it behooves all parties to gather as much of the public together as possible to deliver the same message at one public hearing, i.e., Inland/Wetlands, Planning & Zoning, WPCA, Zoning Board of Appeals, WLSD, etc.

WPCA Update of Planned Procedures

The updating of the *Water Pollution Control Plan for the Town of Goshen, Connecticut, February 1988*, is in DRAFT form. Upon input from the WLSD, the final report will be placed on the agenda for approval and recorded vote.

Chairman Zavagnin is trying to get Jim Mersfelder of WLSD and Martin Connor, Planning and Zoning Officer, attend **the next WPCA meeting on Tuesday, September 20, 2016** to address any questions that may be outstanding.
