Minutes from December 29,2020 were approved by Marty Harris, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Michele Fitzpatrick. Vote was unanimous.

Dog Pond reported that they have applied for the DEEP Grant and are expecting NEAR to do a survey in and make recommendation as to what the next steps are as a result of lack of funding last year.

Tyler Lake stated that they have also applied for the DEEP Grant and are waiting for the Endangered Species to give the OK. They have also applied for a whole lake treatment and are waiting for clearance from the Endangered Species group for the permit to be issued. They will also do follow up testing on readings from last years testing to determine the sources of the high readings

Woodridge Lake expects to receive their permit for carp within the next week. They have completed the required barriers at exit points and are planning on buying 879 carp in this year and restocking again next year. They did a herbicide treatment last fall and are looking forward to seeing the results this summer.

West Side Pond no report.

Mark commented that the Selectmen's budget included the Town Grant money to the lakes but it will be a tough financial year for the Town and it is imperative that we get real support for the Board of Finance meeting on April 28<sup>th</sup>. A presentation will be made to them by Chris Sanders. The link will be sent to the committee for their distribution. It will be a Zoom meeting
