5. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Richard McCarty for Dana & Marc Duneier, 138 East Hyerdale Drive - Shoreline stabilization - Mr. McCarty & Connor walked the property this morning and it was determined that riprap was needed. Shoreline was done many years ago but the ice has done damage. No expansion will be done and will just be doing up and down per Mr. McCarty.

MOTION by Mr. Kinsella and seconded by Mr. Koenig, it was VOTED to accept the application of Richard McCarty for Dana & Marc Duneier, 138 East Hyerdale Drive, Shoreline stabilization. Motion carries.

B. Richard McCarty for Mary Hill, 192 East Hyerdale Drive - Shoreline stabilization & rain garden to control erosion - Property has never had riprap or shoreline stabilization. Very steep and trees going into the lake. Mr. McCarty and Mr. Connor walked property today and Mr. Connor stated that it will need a more detailed plan and will require an engineer to get the erosion under control.

MOTION by Mr. Koenig and seconded by Mr. Wadhams, it was VOTED to accept the application of Richard McCarty for Mary Hill, 192 East Hyerdale Drive, Shoreline stabilization & rain garden to control erosion with a detailed plan and drawings. Motion carries.

C. Michael & Daniel Prause, 679 Sharon Turnpike - Construction of house, septic, and two outbuildings partially in the upland regulated area - There was a house on the property that was demolished. Wetlands have been flagged and a soils report was submitted and Mr. Colby went over the drawings. There is no plan to remove any plants and more discussion was had on the wetlands. Mr. Connor stated that the 2 unpermitted coverage sheds need to be cleared up. He had spoken to Torrington Area Health and they should have approval before the next meeting.

Mr. Connor gave a brief review of this month's report and noted that Mr. Phalen wanted his application tabled to the 3/2/23 meeting and that the owners of 135 Allen Road are looking at some type of educational facility or school and he thinks there may be too many wetlands.
