Valentine would like to remind residents that The Town of Goshen, in cooperation with Take 2, Inc. will be hosting a **FREE** Residential Electronics Recycling Collection event at the Goshen Town Hall located at 42 North Street. Residents are encouraged to bring their unwanted electronics to the drive up/drive through electronics collection event on Saturday, April 7th between 8am and 12noon.

Take 2 Inc. will be on site to unload vehicles and safely package and transport all equipment to their Waterbury facility to be responsibly and securely recycled. Take 2 employees will also assist vehicles in the lot.

**Accepted materials include**, but are not limited to: Computers, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Monitors, TVs, Cell Phones, Tablets, Video Games, game consoles, VCR/DVD Machines, Remotes, Keyboards, Small Appliances, Light Bulbs and Batteries. **Unaccepted materials** include: smoke detectors, propane tanks, paint, household hazardous waste and appliances containing Freon, i.e. air conditioners, refrigerators, and dehumidifiers.

Take 2 Inc. is a Waterbury based electronics recycler. Take 2 is approved by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection as a Covered Electronics Recycler in conjunction with Connecticut's Electronics Recycling Law, RCSA 22a-638-1.
